Confirmation is hereby given on behalf of and on the authority of the above manufacturer/importer that the manufacturer/importer complies with Art. 33 (1) of the REACH Directive (EC) 1907/2006.

In particular, confirmation and assurance are given with respect to the following:

1. That Gerd Bär GmbH will be provided the information required to safely use products containing substances of very high concern (SVHCs) as defined by the REACH Directive (EC) 1907/2006 with a concentration of more than 0.1% by weight, or at least the name of the substance in question. The delivered products do not contain any other substances of very high concern (SVHCs) as defined by the REACH Directive with the corresponding concentration, as a result of which the manufacturer/importer does not have any other obligation to provide information pursuant to Art. 33 (1) of the REACH Directive.
2. That the composition of the delivered products has been verified and checked with respect to substances of very high concern as defined by the REACH Directive (EC) 1907/2006.
3. That in the event of relevant changes in legislation or the composition of a product's materials, Gerd Bär GmbH will be informed without delay and receive an updated declaration in order for the manufacturer/importer to immediately satisfy its obligation under the REACH Directive (EC) 1907/2006.

The above statements apply to all identical copies of the product and take into account the past rulings of the European Court of Justice, according to which the threshold of 0.1 percent by weight is to be applied to sub-products used to create the overall product.
